DEEP update

- First proposal found interest in the community and in TTC
- TERENA is willing to fund aprox. 50%
- Some but not enough NRNs agreed to participate in funding
- Additional funding could be found in the US
- Some new developments in the US
EduPerson
- No development in GridPerson



DEEP update

- Plan to redraft (and possibly rename) the proposal
 - To put some of the work on other shoulders (user requirements survey)
 - To include new developments
 - To put the focus on harmonisation with Internet2 attempt
 - To include work on user preferences, privacy statements

Schema registry

- IETF work on schema registry ready
- Open Group attempt to set it up failed
- Grassroot approach in Honkong ceased
 - Person is still interested in the project
- Chance for a TERENA project proposal

 - of all existing standardized schema
 - of other pseudo standards (NDS, Netscape)
- **Meta-data format revisited**
- **Policy on what and how to register**
- **Software for web based registering of new schema**
- **Business model for running the schema registry as continuous service**
